**TRAVEL IN CANADA** - At the border, proof of citizenship may be required. A driver's licence or photocopy of a birth certificate is best, as well as a signed parental permission slip for those in the group under 18 yrs. of age. When you cross the border from International Falls to Fort Frances, Ontario, you are just 90 miles from Atikokan. Most insurance companies cover your vehicle in Canada, but it is best to check with your agent prior to leaving home. Atikokan has an excellent hospital and clinic. You should have health insurance numbers for each member of the group and they should be certain the coverage is applicable in Canada. We would be happy to send you a sample "HEALTH FORM AND PARENTAL PERMISSION SLIP" if it would help.
